### **GM Container Operations Retires**

Napier Port (NZX.NPH) today announces Warren Young, General Manager Container Operations, has given notice of his intention to retire, ending 21 years of service to the company. Mr Young, who has previously served as the Port's Finance Manager and manager of its container packing operation Port Pack, will leave the Port on 24 December 2019.
